

Dear CHE Parents/Guardians,

To enhance the safety of all students, as well as improve and ease traffic flow around the school, the City of Richland Hills studied the traffic around our campus and developed new traffic flow patterns which are being implemented for the 2023–24 school year. In response to these changes, Cheney Hills Elementary has revised its traffic flow pattern in the campus parking lots that should ease congestion for the students who walk to school, drivers who drop off and pick up students, as well as for nearby homeowners who need to be able to enter and exit their driveways.

**New traffic patterns** will be observed (on school days only) at the following times:

7:00–9:00 a.m.

2:30–5:30 p.m.

- **On school days during the hours above, *Dreeben Drive and Crites Street are one-way streets. No right turns onto Allena Drive (toward the school) are permitted* from the following:**

Crites Street

Gerome Street

Mary Boaz Street

- **Most direct route for morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up (from Baker Blvd.):**

Go south on Dreeben Drive (a **one-way street**) to the campus.

Follow the path in the parking lot to the drop-off/pick-up zones designated by numbered cones.

Exit the parking lot by turning right onto to Dreeben Drive and proceed onto Allena Lane which will take you to Rufe Snow Drive. Drivers may turn right or left on Rufe Snow Drive.

- **Alternate routes:**

If coming from east of the campus, you may take the short road that runs behind Soli-Deo Church off Crites to go to Dreeben Drive. Turn left onto Dreeben Drive and proceed toward the school.

- **Parent drop-off/pick-up line will be in the north parking lot (the big one off Dreeben Drive).**

Cones will be placed in the parking lot to “snake” vehicles through the lot to keep as many vehicles off the street as possible.

Follow the cones toward the student drop off area in front of the school near the cafeteria.

Afternoon dismissals will also be from the cafeteria. This will allow us to keep most of the students safely inside the building until their ride has entered the parking lot. Pull up to a numbered cone and we will load your child into your car.

***PLEASE REMEMBER:*** In the afternoon students are escorted by teachers **across the bridge to the remote parking lot on McCullar Street** (just west of the campus off Carson Road) and are monitored just like the students at the front of the school. ***We strongly recommend that parents who wish to park and walk up to retrieve their students park in the remote lot off Carson Road.***



Estimados padres/tutores de CHE,

Para mejorar la seguridad de todos los estudiantes, así como mejorar y facilitar el flujo de tráfico alrededor de la escuela, la Ciudad de Richland Hills estudió el tráfico alrededor de nuestro plantel y desarrolló nuevos patrones de flujo de tráfico que se están implementando para el año escolar 2023-24. En respuesta a estos cambios, Cheney Hills Elementary ha revisado su patrón de flujo de tráfico en los estacionamientos del plantel que deben aliviar la congestión para los estudiantes que caminan a la escuela, los conductores que dejan y recogen a los estudiantes, así como para los propietarios de viviendas cercanas que necesitan ser capaces de entrar y salir de sus estacionamientos.

**Los nuevos patrones de tráfico se observarán (sólo los días lectivos) en los siguientes horarios:**

7:00–9:00 a.m.

2:30–5:30 p.m.

- **En días de clases durante las horas mencionadas arriba, Dreeben Drive y Crites Street seran calles de un solo sentido. No se permiten vueltas a la derecha en Allena Drive (hacia la escuela) desde las siguientes calles:**

Crites Street

Gerome Street

Mary Boaz Street

- **Ruta más directa para dejar a los niños por la mañana y recogerlos por la tarde (desde Baker**

**Blvd. en la dirección de la escuela) y de regreso a casa desde Baker Blvd. en la dirección de la escuela.)**
